

# **SAFETY**

1. DO NOT LOAD YOUR GUN EXCEPT WHEN STANDING AT SHOOTING POSITION AND NOT UNTIL IT IS YOUR TURN TO SHOOT. IF THE RED FLAG GOES UP, IMMEDIATELY UNLOAD YOUR GUN AND WAIT UNTIL THE RED FLAG GOES DOWN INDICATING READY.
2. LOAD ONE SHELL ONLY IN YOUR GUN AT A TIME FOR SINGLES OR TWO SHELLS FOR DOUBLES.
3. DO NOT CARRY YOUR GUN WITH THE BREECH CLOSED.
4. DO NOT PLACE YOUR HAND OR ANY OTHER PART OF YOUR BODY OVER THE MUZZLE OF YOUR GUN.
5. DO NOT POINT YOUR GUN IN THE DIRECTION OF ANY PERSON EVEN THOUGH YOU KNOW THE GUN IS NOT LOADED.
6. ALWAYS CARRY YOUR GUN WITH THE BREECH OPEN AND THE MUZZLE DOWN.
7. ONLY TARGET LOADS MAY BE USED, MAXIMUM POWDER CHARGE - 3 DRAM EQUIVALENT WITH SHOT SIZES 7-1/2, 8, 8-1/2 AND 9.
8. EACH INDIVIDUAL SHOULD HAVE HIS OWN GUN. THE PRACTICE OF SHARING A GUN IS DANGEROUS.
9. PROTECTIVE SHOOTING GLASSES AND EAR PLUGS OR MUFFS ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
10. ALL EMPTY HULLS WHICH HIT THE GROUND ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE CLUB.
11. ALL ADJUSTMENTS OF THE TRAP AND SKEET MACHINES ARE TO BE MADE ONLY BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.
12. ALL LOADING OF TRAP OR SKEET MACHINES IS TO BE DONE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.
13. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SHOOTING PRIVILEGES TO ANY INDIVIDUAL POSSESSING FAULTY FIREARMS AND/OR AMMUNITION. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXPEL ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO, IN THE OPINION OF THE SHOOT COMMITTEE, DISRUPTS THE HARMONY OF THE TOURNAMENT.
14. THE CLUB AND THE ALBERTA PROVINCIAL TRAP SHOOTING ASSOCIATION ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR INJURIES OR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM THE MISUSE OF FIREARMS, OR FROM THE USE OF FAULTY FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION.
15. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SHOOTING PRIVILEGES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO, IN THE OPINION OF THE SHOOT COMMITTEE, ARE NOT IN A MENTAL OR PHYSICAL CONDITION TO HANDLE A FIREARM.
